## **Parent Code of Conduct**

Parents are vital in helping their children, maintain high, moral character, but feel their commitment and keep a positive attitude. Cheer in motion wants to serve as a partner to the parents, helping each child achieve these goals, but the primary job lies with the parents. Please read this carefully and understand that you are making a commitment of time and financial resources. You are also committing to support our programs, philosophies and goals.

- 1) I understand that my actions at practices, events, and competitions are a reflection of Cheer 'N Motion and should be of strong, moral character. I will be a positive role model for my child, and will encourage good sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all participants, coaches, and spectators at every practice and competition.
- 2) I am aware of the time commitment and will do everything in my ability to enable my child to participate in our practices, workshops, and competitions/performances throughout the season. I understand that a team is depending on my child to fulfill her responsibilities as a team member. I will do all that is necessary to get my child to practice on time and ensure that she is not picked up early. I will not pull my child out of practice early without communicating with the coach. I will pick my child up from practice on time.
- 3) I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will not feel defeated by the outcome of a competition or her performance. I will encourage my child to be a humble winner, and a gracious loser.
- 4) I will respect the coaches and their authority during practices, events and competitions, and will not question, discuss or confront the coaches during a practice or a competition. I will schedule to speak with the coaches at an agreed-upon time and place. This includes venting, or being disrespectful on all social media platforms.
- 5) I understand that, threatening to pull my child from the team, will result in her immediate dismissal.
- 6) If my child is involved in any manner of disrespect towards any Cheer 'N Motion staff member or participant, I will resolve this problem with my child immediately.
- 7) I understand that my child must wear the proper practice attire that is scheduled for any specific day and will support this requirement with my child. If my child misplaces any part of her practice wear, I understand that I must purchase a replacement immediately.
- 8) I fully understand that the coaches reserve the right to suspend my child's participation indefinitely at practice or competition, as a disciplinary action if any of the rules, policies or codes of conduct are not adhered to.
- 9) I will attend, parent meetings, read emails, and check the website to retrieve information that Cheer 'N Motion has prepared.
- 10) I fully understand the financial commitment, and agree to pay all fees on time. If my account becomes 30 days past due, my child may be removed from the routine and/or program until the account is brought current.
